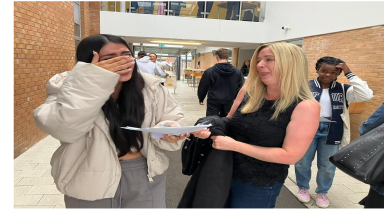

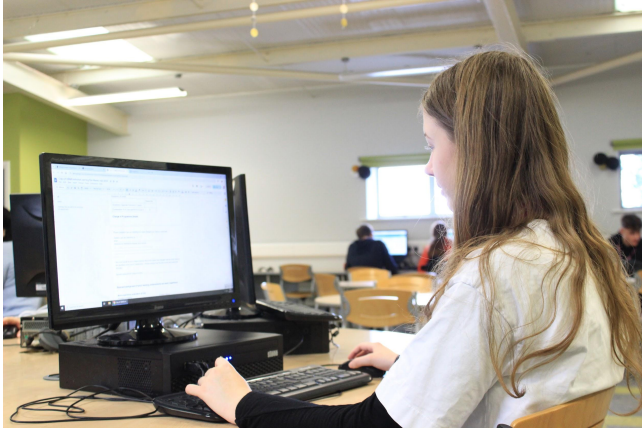

If the course is deemed not suitable then a conversation will take place between teacher, student and parent to agree a way forward.
